

FYI sequoias ready to be revealed

Two of four giant sequoia vignettes will be revealed tomorrow at Fresno Yosemite International Airport as part of its “Sequoiascape” project that began in April.

The project, slated for completion by the end of June, was created to celebrate Fresno’s proximity to three national parks and to provide a memorable experience for all who travel in and our of city.

Designed by NatureMaker, Inc., located in Carlsbad, Calif., the project will feature four “forested” locations with Sequoia Firs, pines, fallen logs, and other foliage, including a giant walk-through Sequoia tree.

The unveiling of the two sequoia vignettes will take place at 5 p.m. tomorrow in the airport’s central terminal lobby, where light refreshments will be served. A brief program will commemorate the project featuring Mayor Ashley Swearengin, Councilmember Larry Westerlund, Aviation Director Russ Widmar. Joining them will be Kings Canyon National Park Superintendent Craig C. Axtell, Yosemite National Park Superintendent David V. Uberuaga and NatureMaker artist Gary Hanick
